Veterinary, breeding & foaling history:

- Grania is cooperative for handling during veterinary exams and for the farrier. She had a bad experience with shots as a foal, but responded well to patience and is now fine as long as the process is not rushed and peppermint treats are supplied.
- Fresh semen was used for all three foals and she settled easily with each breeding.
- All pregnancies have resulted in a live foal.
- Grania has always foaled unassisted and without incident. She is a loving mother and readily allows people to handle her and the foal.
